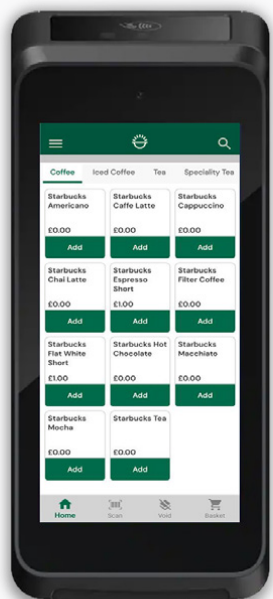


Mobile Point of Sale (PoS)

Time2Eat Mobile Point of Sale (mPOS) extends the Time2Eat ordering and payment experience to a flexible handheld device, enabling staff to take orders and process payments anywhere. Designed for small service environments, like mobile food trucks or food stalls. mPOS can also be used as a queue buster at busy bars, cafes and restaurants to maintain service speed during peak periods. Wireless connection to the Kitchen Management Screen (KMS) to support a fast paced service in a small space.

Installation Requirement
